**Ducklings, Goslings** - Young water birds can't survive on their own until they are well feathered. If a duckling is found alone, look for the parent bird and other youngsters and try to reunite them. If the youngster is calling, the parent may return for it if there are no people in the immediate area. If this doesn't work, the duckling should be put in a box in the same way as described for songbird nestlings.
