Finch Nestlings

**Nestlings** - are naked or downy, don't yet have all their proper feathers and should still be in the nest. If they are found out of the nest, try to locate the nest and put them back. If the whole nest comes down, try to put it back up or rig up something as near as possible to the original location. Watch from a distance to see if the parents return to feed the youngsters. If this isn't possible, put the bird(s) in a small box with some bathroom tissue in the bottom and some small air holes in the sides. Cover the box and put in a warm (not hot), quiet place. Tiny birds need to be fed frequently so try to get them to Wolf Hollow as soon as possible.
