

Sparrows and other nook/cavity nesting birds

Issue- nesting in holes in siding, roofing or in vents.

Note – preventative action should be taken in fall/winter, before nesting season begins in spring.

Suggestions -

- ▶ Seal holes in structures that are larger than $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in diameter, using wood, hardware cloth, aluminum flashing, or other suitable materials.
- ▶ Install vent guards on exhaust or dryer vents.
- ▶ If a nest is active, leave the nest until the young fly off (~2-3 weeks) then remove all nesting material and seal the hole.
