Job Title: Seasonal Rehabilitator Updated: January 10, 2023

Location – Wolf Hollow Wildlife Rehabilitation Center on San Juan Island, Washington State.

Duration – Spring/Summer 2023 (April 1st through September 30th)

Hours – Full-time + On-call, evening feeds, including weekends

Compensation – \$1,000/month and off-site housing

**Primary Objective**: To participate in all aspects of animal care and rehabilitation. To train and supervise animal care interns and volunteers.

- 1. Permanent Rehab Staff
- 2. Executive Director

## **Responsibilities:**

#### A. Treatment of Animals

- 1. Follow treatment plans for injured or orphaned wildlife as approved by the Rehab Staff.
- 2. Work with other members of Rehab Team to establish diet and feeding schedules.
- 3. Use best and appropriate medication and procedures to treat animals.
- 4. Perform daily animal care tasks, including night feeds.
- 5. Perform animal exams and intakes.
- 6. Use knowledge of natural history to determine appropriate caging.
- 7. Learn and utilize emergency care and force-feeding techniques.
- 8. Follow Wolf Hollow's policies pertaining to animal care, release and euthanasia.
- 9. Minimize stressful stimuli to animals in Wolf Hollow's care.
- 10. Respond to emergency calls, including some nights on call.
- 11. Work with the Rehab Staff to maintain an adequate inventory of animal food and basic care supplies.

### **B.** Supervision

- 1. Provide basic training and supervision to animal care volunteers and interns.
- 2. Assist Rehab Staff with ongoing training and supervision of interns and volunteers.
- 3. Assign suitable tasks to animal caregivers and oversee their execution.

#### C. Administration

- 1. Assist Rehab Staff in keeping all patients' charts/records up to date.
- 2. Keep personal timesheets and submit to the Rehab Staff at the end of each month.
- 3. Oversee the completion of animal care volunteers' time sheets.
- 4. Participate in meetings as requested by the Rehab Staff or Executive Director.

#### D. Facilities

- 1. Assist in keeping all areas of Wolf Hollow clean and in good repair. Inform Rehab Staff of needed repairs.
- 2. Help maintain environmentally responsible practices (eg. recycling, water conservation).
- 3. Assist with routine maintenance and repairs of cages and other rehab facilities.

#### E. Knowledge

- 1. Learn and apply to animal care, the natural history of each patient.
- 2. Have knowledge of Wolf Hollow's mission statement, policies and procedures.

#### F. Interaction with the Public

- 1. Interact with the public in a polite and professional fashion, both in person and over the phone.
- 2. Provide helpful and accurate information with regard to wildlife topics.

## **Qualifications**

**Required** – Must be 18 or over. Minimum of 6 months experience in wildlife rehabilitation in a paid or volunteer position, working through a busy summer season and with a range of wildlife species, including mammals and birds.

Have a valid driver's license.

**Desired** – Experience training and supervising others and working in a fast-paced environment. Good communication skills. Basic knowledge of the natural history of a range of wild species and of animal anatomy and physiology. Good physical fitness level to be able to work long hours during the busy summer season.
