Location – Wolf Hollow Wildlife Rehabilitation Center on San Juan Island, Washington State.

Duration – Summer 2024 (Ideally May to Sept, but as much of that time period as possible. Exact start and finish dates somewhat flexible.)

Hours - 4-5 days/week. (including Saturdays)

Compensation – On-site housing and stipend provided.

Role – to **Assist the Education Coordinator** with a wide range of tasks involved in the Education Outreach Program at Wolf Hollow, including, but not limited to:-

- Design and production of educational materials.
- Care of education birds
- Educational Presentations
- Manning information booths at events.
- Creating and leading children’s activities.
- Web Site updates.
- Production of educational artifacts
- Cataloging photographic materials.

- Learn more about the wildlife of the San Juan Islands and adjacent mainland, human impacts on wildlife, and the work of a wildlife rehabilitation center.
